

## POOH-BAHS OF THE CLASS OF 1933

For our 55th reunion Dave Ludlum, after considerable research, constructed a list of Class Officers "back through time". Discovering a gap in our Class history, which he labeled "The Great Interregnum", he put his talents to work and made the following report:

"The Great Interregnum had its seeds in a meeting of a cabal of classmates at the Princeton Club of New York in the spring of 1938. A coup d'état was staged and the unwritten constitution of 1933 trampled on. It was decided to abolish Class officers and set up a central committee of New Yorkers to run Class affairs. The only name now known to have been associated with this revolutionary group was one, Tony Nichol, who was appointed chairman in late winter 1939. The exigencies attending World War II scattered this committee to the four winds. During the war years Class affairs were handled mainly by Secretary Mettler and Treasurer Pell.

"Steps toward restoration of constitutional government took place in the winter-spring of 1946. A general amnesty was declared for all revisionists. Nominations for Class officers were solicited and election cards sent to all classmates with the request that they bring them to our 13th reunion in June 1946. An election was held. Billings was named President and Purnell vice-president. The new regime promised a written constitution which was duly approved by the Class at our 15th reunion in June 1948. The incumbent officers were then reelected to serve full five year terms running to June 1953.
