Five years ago our Annual Giving goal was \$333,333.33. Had we looked back last fall with some 85 less classmates than in '93 we would have said, "No way can we make the same goal." But we didn't look back and we did set \$333,333.33 as our goal—and *you* made it!

Along the way (when you passed \$310,000) you set a new record for 65th anniversary year classes!

How did you make the goal? First a very small handful of you (who are too modest to be recognized individually—you know who you are) made a few very very substantial gifts giving us a *big* head start. Next when invited to make additional gifts before June 30th, thirty-eight of you contributed a critical extra \$45,000. Thirdly, our class associates gave an essential \$75,000. Finally, while all classes struggled to reach 63% participation, '33 again declared, "there's no Udder like it" and hit 73%.

Our effort, though only a soft voice in the \$31 million Annual Giving total, speaks a very loud message of faith in Princeton's ability to provide leaders for the future, the world our loved ones will live in.
