He graduated Phi Beta Kappa from Princeton in 1962, spent the following year at Cambridge University as a Keasbey Scholar, and received his law degree from Harvard in 1966. He served as university general counsel from 1972-1990. He teaches an occasional class in the Department of Politics.

The annual dinner is also the time when our club presents its check to Princeton for scholarship support - a gift made possible by the generous support of the many patrons who made contributions to our club's scholarship fund at the HYP Ball in December.
