This year, forty-nine Rochester-area students applied for admission to the class of 2007. Twenty-eight Rochester-area alumni volunteers, under the direction of Schools Committee Chair Dr. Michael Schneider '72, interviewed 42 of the 49 applicants. 10 of the applicants (20.4%) were offered admission, and 7 students accepted Princeton's offer of admission and are enrolled for the fall semester. Thanks to Dr. Michael Schneider '72 and his committee, each applicant received a chance to bolster their knowledge of Princeton and credentials for admission with an extensive personal interview.
